Guests can be suspended or terminated based on the following: wearing inappropriate attire, using vulgar language; making physical contact with a person in an angry or threatening way; engaging in sexual activity or contact with another person in the YMCA facility or property, harassing or intimidating by words, gestures, body language or any other menacing behavior towards another member, program participant, volunteer or staff member; stealing or other behavior, which results in destruction of property; carrying or concealing any weapons, devices or objects which may be used as a weapon; using or possessing illegal chemicals, drugs or alcohol on YMCA property or vehicles; smoking; any other conduct of an inappropriate, threatening or offensive nature; and refusing to adhere to staff request of guest to follow YMCA policies. **Signature required by all in camping party.**
