After School Academy is part of the YMCA's history of dedication to youth development. It was established to meet the

needs of working parents while providing children with a fun, safe, and enriching environment. Our program offers a variety of daily activities focusing on the following:

BUILD YOUR OWN PLAN:

Choose an option that works for you! After School, Spring Break and Out of School days. A one time \$50 registration fee applies to all before and after school options.

Ward Elementary After School (monthly)

- 5 days a week: \$265 members / \$315 potential members
- 3 days a week: \$235 members / \$270 potential members

Kimmel Farm Elementary After School (monthly)

- 5 days a week: \$225 members / \$275 potential members
- 3 days a week: \$195 members / \$230 potential members

Before School (monthly)

- 5 days a week: \$75 members / \$85 potential members
- Before School Drop In: \$15/day
- After School Drop In: \$20/day
- Sibling Discount: \$20 per child per month after the first child
- Military/First Responder (Fire, Police, EMS) Discount: \$20 per child per month

The above discounts can be applied with Financial Scholarships, but no other discounts, i.e. parents cannot receive a multi-sibling discount AND a military/first responder discount.
