It was established to meet the needs of working parents while providing children with a fun, safe, and enriching environment. Our program offers a variety of daily activities focusing on the following:

Learning doesn't stop when the school day ends. The Y provides the academic support needed to help students achieve their full potential. Each day is filled with educational activities that also incorporate active play to develop a lifelong love of health and wellness.

BUILD YOUR OWN PLAN:

Choose an option that works for you! After School, Spring Break and Out of School days. A one time \$50 registration fee applies to all before and after school options.

After School (monthly)

- 5 days a week: \$230 members / \$285 potential members
- 3 days a week: \$145 members / \$180 potential members
- After School Drop In: \$25/day
- Sibling Discount: \$20 per child per month after the first child
- Military/First Responder (Fire, Police, EMS) Discount: \$20 per child per month

The above discounts can be applied with Financial Scholarships, but no other discounts, i.e. parents cannot receive a multi-sibling discount AND a military/first responder discount.
