During 2025, 3,185 volunteers provided 39,919 hours of service throughout our Association as board members, storytellers, coaches, and program volunteers.



Our Community Impact

BY THE NUMBERS

Nearly **65,000** meals were served to **2,500** young people in our Summer Day Camps.

1,450 children participated in our fun and enriching Before and After School Academies in the 2024-2025 school year.

55 blood drives were hosted across the Association and **1,303** pints of blood were collected, saving **3,909** lives.

771 middle and high school students were provided with a safe space to go outside of school hours through the Reaching Our Potential teen membership program.

305 Youth and Government delegates gained a deep understanding of the importance of civic literacy, advocacy, and state government.

\$2,965,000 in financial scholarships were given for memberships and programs.

183 youth in the Achievers programs learned about the tools needed for success in higher education and career opportunities in the 2024-2025 school year.

65 students from Title-I schools participated in our free Summer Learning Academies.

1,340 campers experienced adventure and the great outdoors during overnight camp at YMCA Camp Hanes, while another **728** campers attended day camp.

We spent approximately **\$1 million** on new equipment for our members, potential members and guests.

Together, we accomplished so much to enrich lives throughout our service area! Take a look at a few highlights of our impact:


- \$3.4M in scholarships, subsidies and financial assistance to ensure access for ALL
- Tutoring and literacy support allowed 410 adults to improve their education and enhance employment opportunities
- 874 youth were served by our Bright Beginnings initiative, which provides students with stocked bookbags, new clothes and new shoes to start the school year with confidence
- 137 teens participated in Teen Talks, which encourage mental health and resilience in our young adult population
- Targeted health services through Community Integrated Health programs benefitted 1150 individuals
- Over 20,800 older adults built community and improved their health by engaging in wellness classes and active older adult programming

Of course, this work is made exponentially stronger by the cooperation of strong partners. Novant Health, Goodwill Industries of Northwest North Carolina, Habitat for Humanity, local law enforcement agencies and institutions of higher learning come alongside us to address some of the community's most important topics: health equity, youth safety, and education. 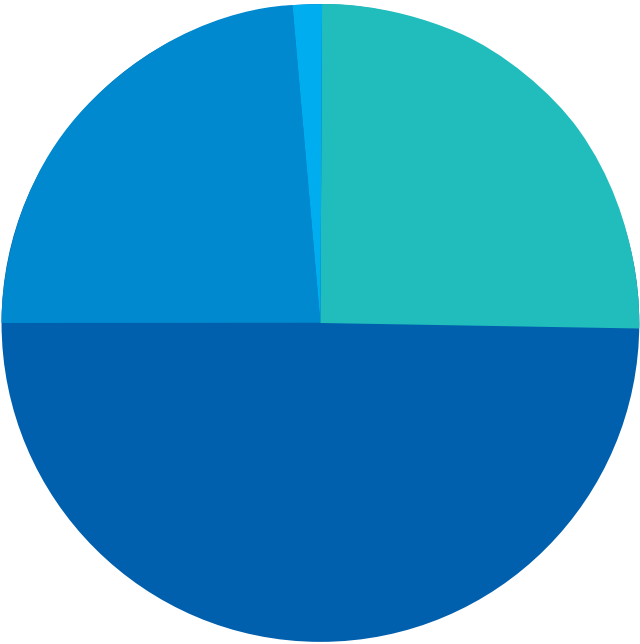

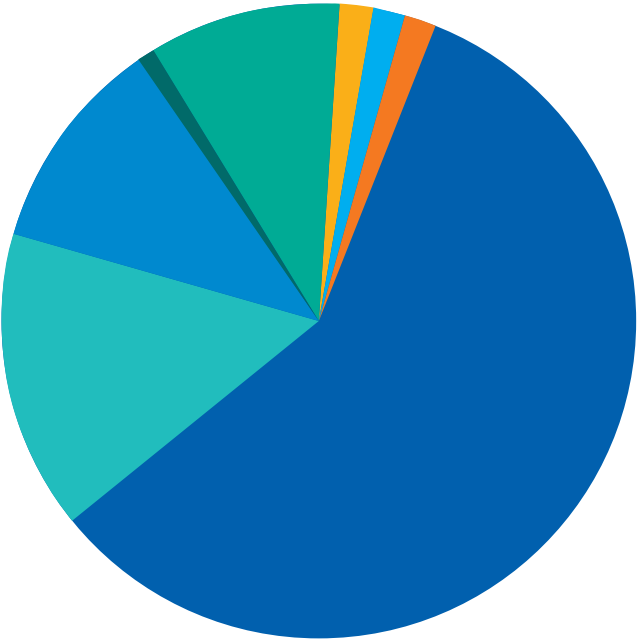
